



The Year of 2023

12023 marked the 98th anniversary of the Benedek Memorial Library (formerly the Savona Free Library) serving our communities with a multitude of library services. Those services include access to a collection of print books, magazines, audio books, music CDs, DVDs multi-media kits and access to the collections form the 47 libraries in the Southern Tier Library System and the ability to borrow from all libraries nationwide. Our services to the community have changed over the years with the technology to include public computers, copier services, Wi-Fi 24/7. There is a digital collection of e-books, audio books, e- magazines, databases, and virtual reference desk. To help everyone in our communities we have continued with being fine free when borrowing items. Besides library services, we held 196 programs for all ages though out the year. A new Winter Read Program for young ones started in 2023The Local Historical collection started to take shape. The Library is proud to be a part of the Savona community Events Committee(formed by the non-profits in the community) that strives to bring enrichment to our community. 2023 events included bringing the Sam Pallet Band to Savona for a free afternoon of music and continuing the tradition of Christmas Magic, which provided a chance for community members to come together to celbrate the joy of the season.

The Summer Read Plus: "Together We Can" ran during the months of July and August, with 65 participants. The Summer Read Plus program is to encourage all ages to practice their reading skills by reading for pleasure. Young ones especially need the encouragement to read during the summer to keep from the summer slide. The summer slide is when the young ones go back to school and have to work hard to get back to the level of skill they had at the end of the school year. 2023's theme was "Together We Can" and the library worked to show case the creative skills of the communities with an art exhibit. All participants received a 3x3 inch canvas and a small art kit. All were encouraged to create a small masterpiece using the materials given or anything they already had. During the six weeks of the program, our exhibit grew to over 60 mini master pieces! Also offered were many creative programs for all ages. Two popular programs were the Murder Mystery Dinner and the Paint and Sip program. Participants in the Murder Mystery role-played a character during a dinner to figure out who was the murderer. No one knows who did the deed until after everyone guesses who it might be at the end of the night. The Paint and Sip young adults and adults created a painting of mushroom fairy houses. All drinks were non-alcoholic.

A new program this year was a special Winter Read Program: Adopt a Bookworm. This reading program was for young ones birth through Sr. High School. It was a program to keep young ones engaged with reading through the winter blues. Bookworm bookmarks were crochet by local seniors, from the senior coffee hour, and staff. The participants came to the library. Found and choose the special bookworm they would take care of by reading to it. The program had 20 participants who kept logs of their reading to get brag tags and raffle tickets for a few raffle prizes. All had a great time, but the big winners were the participants keeping up with their reading skills.

A special project was started in 2023 was a Local History collection. The Savona historian started to give the library their personal historical collection. The library started working with Documentary Heritage and Preservation Services for New York (DHPSNY) to start building this special collection. After a couple of meetings we had a game plan to start defining the collection and inventorying the collection. It is going to take time to be able to assess the complete collection and organize the material for use. We have started with the inventory and by using fundraisers and grants to acquire the proper storage equipment and start transforming a space to house the collection. We are hoping to make it available to the public in late 2024 or early 2025
